



## John Henry Lewis

November 23, 1950 - January 1, 2019

A Celebration of Life for Mr. John Henry Lewis, 68, of Louisville, Georgia, who passed peacefully at home with his family at his side January 1, 2019, will be conducted Saturday morning at 11 o'clock in the Louisville Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church with the Reverend Bill Cain officiating.

Mr. Lewis was a life-long resident of Louisville, Georgia. He earned a Civil Engineering Degree from Georgia Tech and was a member of the Louisville Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church where he served as a Deacon, a Past President of the Louisville Lions Club and a Founding Member of the Ogeechee River Keeper Association. Mr. Lewis was the Vice President of Engineering at Fulghum Industries and a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers and the Georgia Society of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. He was predeceased by his mother, Joyce Jones Lewis.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 46 years, Karen Yonchak Lewis; three daughters and sons-in-laws, Elisabeth and Chad Whitaker, Hilary and Christopher Porter and Susanna and Johannes Roubert; five grandchildren, Agnes, Everett, Isabelle, Madeline and Henning; father, Leroy Lewis; two brothers and their wives, Charles and Susanne Lewis and Kenneth and Melody Lewis; mother-in-law, Antoinette Yonchak.
