North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Leonard U. Garvin, 98, who entered into rest December 13, 2018, will be conducted Monday morning at 11 o'clock from Sweetwater Baptist Church. Dr. Paul W. Noe and Dr. Skip Myers officiating. Interment will follow in the Graniteville Cemetery with Veterans Honors.

Mr. Garvin was a native of Aiken County having made Belvedere his home for the past 56 years. He was a member of Sweetwater Baptist Church where he formerly served as a Deacon and Sunday School Teacher for 50 years. Mr. Garvin was a U.S. Army Air Core Veteran of WWII where he flew 23 missions over Germany as a B17 pilot. His aircraft was fondly named "My Bonnie." Mr. Garvin was a member of the Jessie C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71 and has received various honors for his military service including being named one of Aiken's Hometown Hero's. His dedicated military service during WWII is documented in the Smithsonian Institute. Mr. Garvin retired from Sig Cox Heating and Air.

Survivors include two sons and a daughter-in-law, Wallace Garvin, Travelers Rest, SC and Rev. Jerry and Helen Garvin, Trenton, SC; a grandchild, Noelle Etheridge (Cliff); three great-grandchildren, Helen Elizabeth Etheridge, Maggie Anne Etheridge and John Robert Etheridge.

Honorary Pallbearers will be members of the Jessie C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71. Active pallbearers will be members of the Leonard Garvin Prayer Group.

The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service.
