Augusta, GA—Funeral Services for Ms. Linda VanDerburgh Burkhalter, 77, who entered into rest October 17, 2021, will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock at First Presbyterian Church Augusta with Rev. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Wednesday evening from 6 until 8.
