Augusta, GA - Memorial Services for Albert William Duvall, 84, who entered into rest March 24, 2025, will be held at a later date.

Albert was born May 18, 1940, in Augusta Georgia to the late Lafayette and Roma Duvall. He lived here all his school years developing strong values with the Boy Scouts and working a paper route through his teenage years. While taking a drafting class in high school he became interested in Architecture. Albert graduated from Richmond Academy in June of 1958 and enlisted in the Air Force shortly thereafter. He went to basic training and was stationed in Texas for a brief period. While on leave he came home to Augusta where he met his future wife, Alice Faye. He was transferred to Alaska and ended up proposing to Alice by mail. Alice Faye travelled to Alaska with her sister whose husband was already stationed in Alaska and married Albert on September 17, 1960. After being in Alaska for four years Albert and family transferred to Texas, this is when Albert decided to leave the military and move back to Augusta with his family. Upon returning to Augusta, Albert began his career designing homes and other buildings in the area. Mr. Duvall's business and reputation grew as he designed many beautiful homes in the area, under his name Albert W. Duvall Home Designs. Albert was a hard-working, devoted and loving husband and father. He was married to his sweetheart Alice Faye for 65 years. He and his beloved wife and children were active members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.

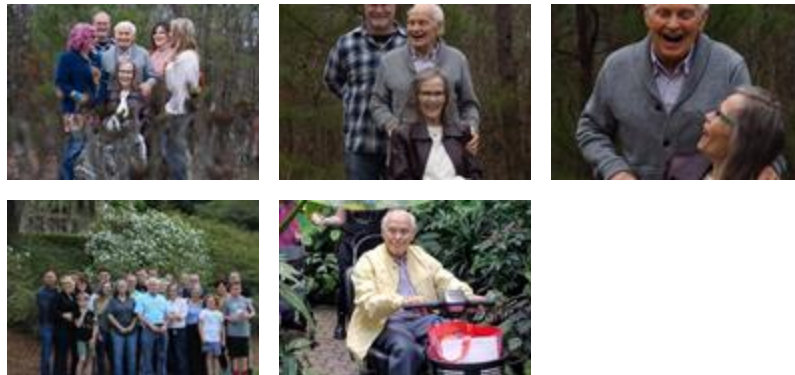
