Alex was a lifelong resident of Aiken. He was a 2005 graduate of South Aiken High School where he was a regional champion cross country runner. Alex was a University of South Carolina Aiken graduate where he received a Bachelor’s Degree in English with a minor in Political Science and was the Editor of the English Newsletter and a member of the National English Honor Society. He was a second year student at the Charleston School of Law. He was a former associate with Henderson Johnson and Whittle Attorneys and a law clerk with a Charleston law firm. An avid swimmer, Alex was a member of the Aiken-Augusta Swim League and the Houndslake Swim Club. He was the grandson of the late Charles P. Ross.

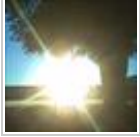
