



Alfred "Dick" William Schoenfelder

September 7, 1928 - July 7, 2024

North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Alfred “Dick” William Schoenfelder, 95, who entered into rest July 7, 2024, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 3 o’clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel, Deacon Robert Hookness officiating. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens with Veteran’s Honors. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service.

Mr. Schoenfelder was born September 7, 1928, in Pottsville, PA to the late Alfred and Mary Schoenfelder. He proudly served his country in the United States Army during World War II. Mr. Schoenfelder retired after a long career as an electrician. He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 1579 and received an award for 70 years of membership. Mr. Schoenfelder was a longtime parishioner at Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church where he was active in the choir for many years. He was a founding member of the Belvedere/North Augusta Ham Radio Operator’s Club. Mr. Schoenfelder earned his private pilot’s license later in life and was involved in the Young Eagles Program at Daniel Field in Augusta. He served as a volunteer with the Augusta Soup Kitchen and Meals on Wheels. Mr. Schoenfelder was a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post 71 where he received the 2010 Legionnaire of the Year Award and was involved with the Ceremonial Corps. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Loraine Schoenfelder; sons, Fred W.

Schoenfelder and Thomas R. Schoenfelder; siblings, Mary Wineland, Rita Schoenfelder, Georgina Strausser and Alice Irick; longtime companion, Margaret Richardson.

Survivors include his daughters, Susan Todd (Teddy), Judy Berry (John) and Christine Jernigan; grandchildren, Scotty Johnston (Barbara), Kelly Bednarczyk (Robert), Jason Berry (Sharon), Valerie Shepard, Stacy Key (John Blount), April Zahner (Micheal), Nikki Byrd (Joseph), Perry Key (Laurie), Jonathan Berry, Stephanie Hall (Troy); 24 great-grandchildren; 9 great-great-grandchildren; stepchildren, Faye Biedler (John), Linda Brown (Gary), Edward Johnson.

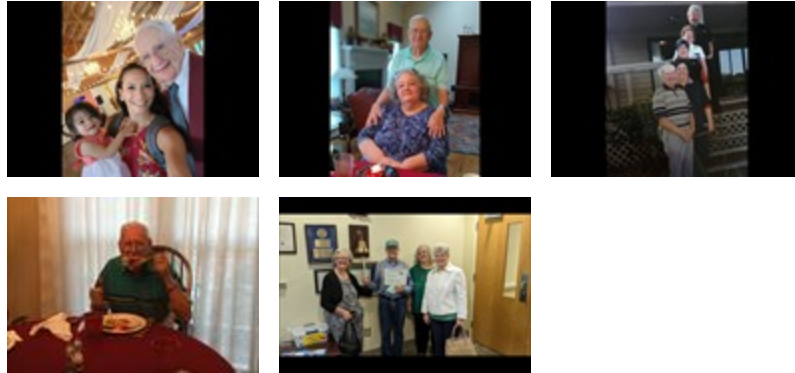
