Mr. Dunn was a native of Orangeburg County, having made Johnston his home for the past 62 years. He was a long-time member of Providence Baptist Church. Mr. Dunn was the owner/operator of Allen's Supermarket in Johnston for 40 years. He served as an Edgefield County Magistrate Judge until he was appointed Clerk of Court by Governor Campbell and served in this position until he retired in 2004. He was long-time member of the Johnston Masonic Lodge, Sertoma and JayCees Clubs. Mr. Dunn was preceded in death by his daughter Barbara Robertson.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years, Claire Dunn; two sons and daughters-in-law, Howard and Mary Dunn, Rockaway, NJ and Allen M. and Robin Dunn, North Augusta, SC; a daughter and son-in-law, Marilyn and Richard McCormick, Saluda, SC; nine grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.
