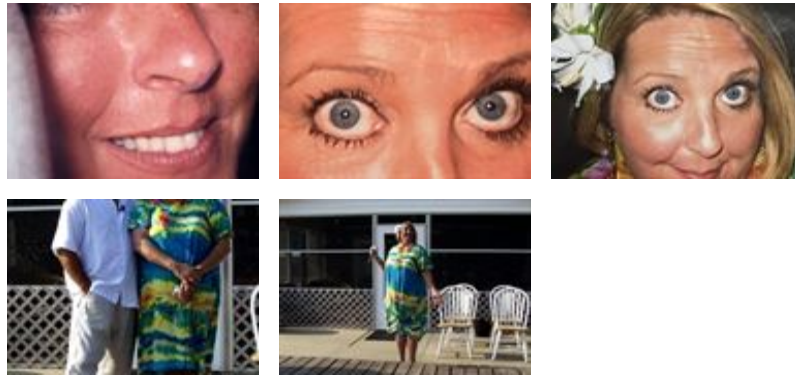

Annie Bug, I will miss you and thank you for being my friend. And please save me spot in Heaven, so we can continue our conversation when I join you.

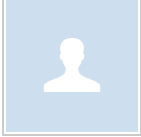
