Jackson, SC – Funeral Services for Mrs. Anne M. Davidson, 92, who entered into rest December 9, 2022, will be conducted Saturday morning, December 17, 2022, at 11 o'clock at First Baptist Church of Jackson. Rev. Brian Henderson, Rev. Roy Kiser, and Dr. Stephen Cutchins officiating. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Friday evening, December 16, 2022, from 6 until 8 o'clock.

Mrs. Davidson was born October 27, 1930, to the late Junius L. and Annie Stover McGuirt. She was a native of Heath Springs, SC, having made Jackson, SC her home for the past 69 years. Mrs. Davidson was a graduate of Winthrop College and later received her master's degree from the University of South Carolina. She was a teacher in Aiken County, working at Jackson High School for many years and retiring from Silver Bluff High School. Mrs. Davidson was known to always have a welcoming home to anyone who needed love and care. She was an incredible mother, who was infinitely proud of her children and grandchildren, who she adored immensely. Her life's passion was teaching children. She loved each of her students and her students loved her. Mrs. Davidson's positive influence has impacted countless lives throughout the years. She was a strong Christian woman and a faithful member of First Baptist Church of Jackson, where she eagerly served her church family and her community.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, James C. "Jimmy" Davidson; and four siblings. Survivors include a son, Dr. J. Michael Davidson, (Phyllis) of Florence, SC; a daughter, Dr. Cecelia D.
