



## Barbara "Judy" Colley

North Augusta, SC – Mrs. Barbara “Judy” Colley, 86, entered into rest May 20, 2025. Memorial Services will be conducted Friday afternoon, May 23rd, at 2 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel with Rev.
