North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Betty Lee House Ayers who was peacefully welcomed into Heaven on the 15th of November 2024 at the age of 76 at Ogeechee Area Hospice in Statesboro, Georgia will be conducted Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel, Pastor Jim Stanley officiating. Interment will follow in Westover Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service.

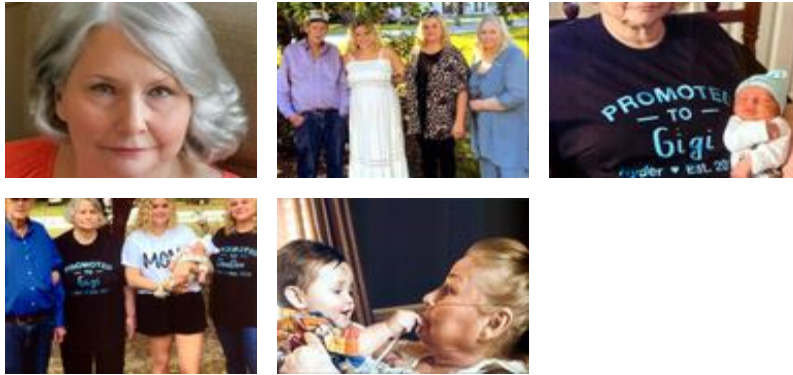
