



Betty Ann Crocker

July 30, 1953 - March 12, 2019

During the afternoon of March 12th, 2019, Betty Ann Crocker passed away at home surrounded by loved ones. She was 65 years old.

Betty was born in Orangeburg, SC. She completed her high school career leading the North Augusta High's fledgling volleyball team to win the first girls' state title in North Augusta history. Betty continued forging the way for women's sports across the nation as she played volleyball for Winthrop University. The team and Betty herself were both inducted into the North Augusta Sports Hall of Fame in 2017 and 2018 respectively.

Betty was a mortgage banker for 27 years where she worked tirelessly to help make people's dreams a reality.

Betty loved to travel which likely developed from growing up with a father in the Army. Her world travels included France, Italy, Guatemala, Tanzania, New Zealand, Iceland, Viet Nam, Cambodia, Thailand, and more. Betty also enjoyed traveling in the United States. Despite her passion for traveling, Betty's favorite place was with good friends and family.

Betty was an inspiration to all who knew her. She loved people, making everyone feel special. Her passion for animals led her to actively support animal rights organizations. Betty's drive and determination fueled her to train for a Tri-Athlon, celebrating her 60th birthday.

Betty is preceded in death by her father Harold Loyd Crocker.

Betty is survived by her mother and step-father Betty and David Beaudreau; brother and sister-in-law Perry and Pam Crocker; niece and nephew, Ashley and Brant; great-niece Lyla Grace; and her partner of 27 years, Dianne Crutchfield.

To celebrate her life, the family will receive guests on Saturday, March 16th at 4 o'clock at Posey Funeral Directors. A Memorial Service will be conducted at 5 o'clock with Bill Trotter officiating.

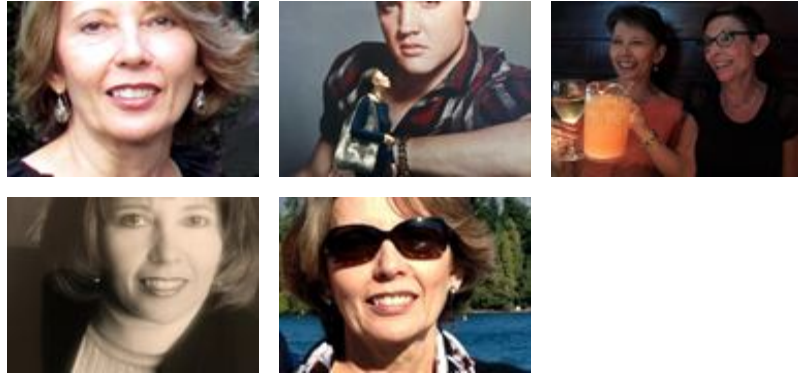
