Billie Jo Chandler Greer moved to her Heavenly home on January 10, 2026, after a wonderful and full life of 91 years. Billie Jo was born to H. A handsome associate pastor in her church swept her off her feet and she partnered with him in ministry for over 50 years in over ten cities in Eastern Alabama and South Georgia with the Methodist Church. She dedicated her life to raising her four children and working tirelessly in her church and community, whether it was singing in the choir, teaching children's Sunday School or helping organize a spaghetti dinner. 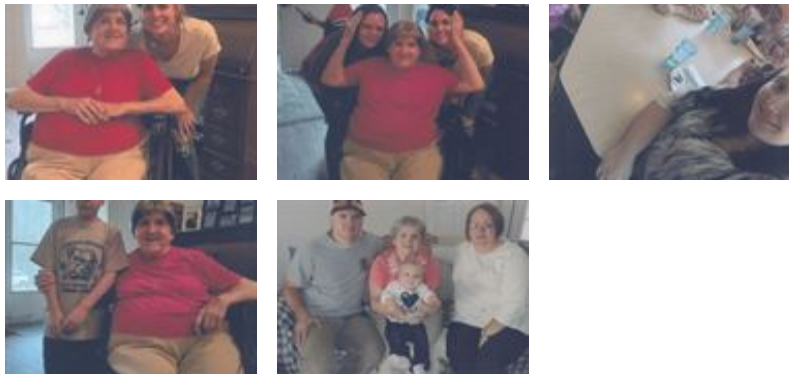
