Brannon was a native of North Augusta but as an Army Veteran had the opportunity to live around the world. He was a 1987 graduate of North Augusta High School and attended Anderson College before entering the U.S. Army. He was a proud SGT in U.S. Army Veteran, having served in the Gulf War during combat with the 82nd Airborne and was a life-time member of the VFW. Following his military service, he worked as a public affairs officer with the civil service. Brannon loved music, especially playing his bass guitar, and was an avid reader and dog lover. He was preceded in death by his father, Jeffery Craig Lamar.
