North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Brenda Deanne Huskey, 84, who entered into rest December 28, 2023, will be conducted Tuesday at Noon from First Baptist Church North Augusta, Rev. Mrs. Huskey was born December 15, 1939, in Asheville, NC to the late Howard and Donnis Ensley. She was a longtime active member of First Baptist Church North Augusta where she was involved as the first kindergarten director of the education program, member of the Bobby Dodd Sunday School Class, and developed a program for the parents of special needs children to be able to attend Sunday service together. Mrs. Huskey retired after a teaching career that spanned over 35 years and various schools in the area. Most notably though she was a dedicated and loving wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Howard Ensley, Jr.

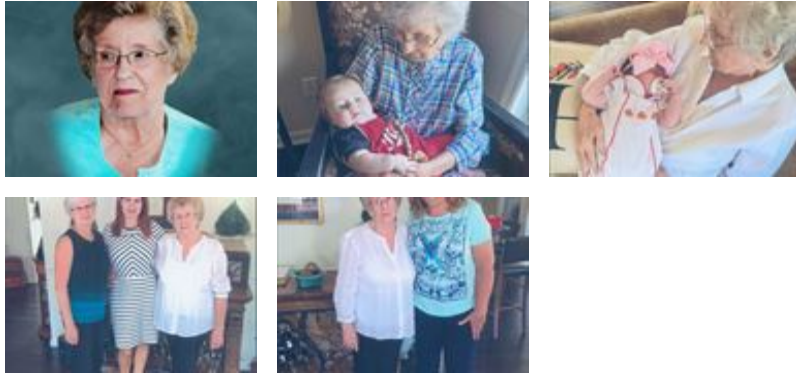
