Mr. Lown was a native of Leesville, SC, having made North Augusta his home for the past 52 years. He was a member of Fairview Presbyterian Church where he had served as an Elder, a US Navy Veteran of World War II and a member of the Board of Trustees of the Thornwell Home for Children. Mr. Lown was the former Principal of Paul Knox Jr. High School and had retired as the Superintendent of the North Augusta Area II Schools. He was active for many years in Church , Community and School Affairs.
