



Byron Baynham

North Augusta, SC—Funeral services for Mr. Byron Baynham, 60, of Lake Avenue, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest March 6, 2008 will be conducted Monday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Dr. Gary C. Redding, Dr. Randy Cooper and Dr. Mac Andrew Bowman officiating. Interment in Sunset Hill Cemetery with Veteran Honors and Masonic Rites.

Byron was a lifelong resident of North Augusta and a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. He was a member of the Acacia Masonic Lodge #315 AFM, a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Scottish and York Rite Bodies. Byron was a also a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71, Beech Island Historical Society, Horse Creek Bottle Club, Horse Creek Historical Society, North Augusta Historical Society, the North Augusta Country Club, served in the US Army during the Vietnam Era and was retired from Westinghouse at the Savannah River Site.. He was the son the late Roy W. Baynham.
