Dr. Johnson was a native of Warrenton, Georgia, having made North Augusta his home for the past 36 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Dr. Johnson attended the Citadel on a Football Scholarship and was a 1976 graduate of the Medical College of Georgia serving a residency in Anesthesiology and a one year residency in Pediatrics at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, followed by a distinguished practice of 41 years in Anesthesiology. He was an avid sports fan having coached and mentored many local youth. Dr. Johnson was predeceased by his parents, C. F. and Margie Johnson and a brother, Jimmy Johnson.
