Mr. Callicott was born June 15, 1919, in Memphis, Tennessee, the only child of Lamar Moisant and Lillie Eason Callicott. He spent his early years in Coldwater, Mississippi, graduating from Coldwater High School in 1938 and attended the Gulf Engineer School in New Orleans.

In the early years of his life he was active in Radio Broadcasting in Decatur, AL(WMSL), Gainesville, GA (WGGA-WHNX) and Carrollton, GA (WLBB) where he helped establish the first radio station. Later, while working at DuPont, he worked part-time in radio broadcasting and then television, working at WJBF as the night PM Engineer and Tape Operator from 1966 until 1998. He retired from the Electrical-Instruments-Maintenance Department at the E.I. DuPont Company at the Savannah River Plant with 31 years of service.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years, Margaret D. Callicott; three daughters

and sons-in-law, Ann & Ed Stalnaker, Bonnie & Pat Arthur, all of Augusta, Margaret & Dwight Gilleland, Dawsonville, GA; eight grandchildren, Craig Stalnaker, Brian Stalnaker, Ben Gilleland, Shelby Gilleland, Sam Gilleland, Megan Arthur, Kelsey Arthur, Patrick Arthur; five great grandchildren.
