North Augusta, SC – A Celebration of Life for Charles Edwin Coleman, 83, who entered into rest on April 18, 2025, will be held Thursday morning, April 24, at 11 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel, with Reverend Craig Baynham officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service at the funeral home.

Born on December 6, 1941, in Thomaston, Georgia, Mr. Coleman was the son of the late Austin and Marion Coleman. He moved with his family to the North Augusta area in his adolescent years and later graduated from North Augusta High School.

His professional journey began behind the camera at a local television station, but it was in advertising sales where he truly found his calling. A natural communicator with a strong, competitive work ethic, he was consistently recognized as top-performing account manager. His passion and persistence propelled him to the role of General Sales Manager at WJBF, a position he held with pride until his retirement at the age of 62.

Mr. Coleman was not only accomplished in his career but also lived a vibrant and active life. From a young age, he displayed exceptional athletic talent, excelling in baseball, boxing, and running—nearly every sport he tried. He enjoyed weightlifting, fishing, shooting pool, and most of all, traveling with the love of his life, his wife of 58 years, Janice H. Coleman, whom he adored. She

preceded him in death, as did his siblings, Martha Kennedy, Clifford “Jack” Coleman, and Michael “Mickey” Coleman.

He will be remembered as a devoted husband, proud father and grandfather, loving uncle and a man of great humor, strength, and most of all heart. His legacy lives on through those who loved him deeply.

He is survived by his daughter, Stacy Chambers (John) of North Augusta; his son, Alex Coleman (Robyn) of North Augusta; four cherished grandchildren, John David Chambers (Ashlee), Matthew Alexander Chambers (Deloncia), Hunter Coleman, and Caitlin Coleman; and a great-granddaughter, Wesleigh Nicole Chambers.
