



Charles Allen Valentine

Funeral Services for Charles (Charlie) Valentine, 86, of North Augusta, SC, who was taken to his heavenly home on August 7, 2024, will be conducted at First Christian Church of Augusta on August 23, 2024, at 2pm with Dr. Brian Ragle officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens.

Charlie was the second of ten children born to Timothy and Edna Valentine from Laurel, Mississippi. Charlie worked at the Savannah River Site in Aiken, SC for over twenty years as a pipefitter. Later transferring to the Zimmer Power Station in Moscow, Ohio where he worked another five years. After retiring from Zimmer, Charlie worked as a Pressman with the Bearing Precious Seed Ministries of the Bible printing and worldwide distribution project in Milford, Ohio. He retired for good in 2007 and moved back to North Augusta. Charlie loved fishing, gardening, reading, watching old western movies, and playing the guitar.

Charlie was preceded in death by his wife of 40 years, Jacqueline Valentine, his parents, Timothy Haskin Valentine and Edna Lois (Stennett) Valentine; four brothers, Jerry Valentine, Benny (Jo-jo) Marlan Valentine, Brent Valentine, Ted Valentine, and sister, Sandra (Valentine) Byrd.

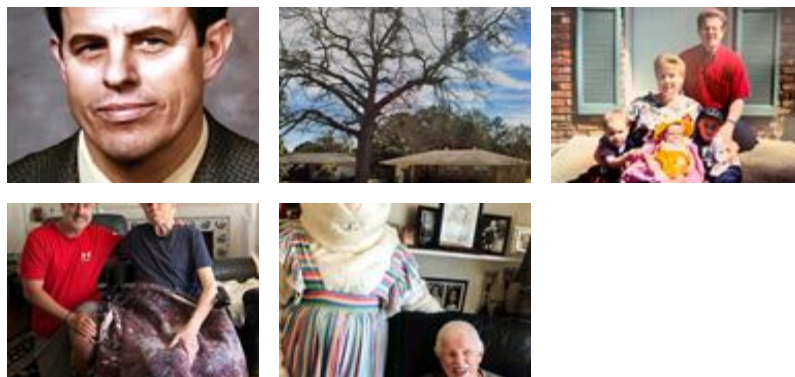
