North Augusta, SC—Mr. Clyde R. Still, 74, of North Augusta, SC went to his heavenly home to be with his Lord on Tuesday, November 13, 2007. He passed away peacefully at home with his family by his side after a courageous battle with pulmonary fibrosis.

Mr. Still was born in Edgefield County and was the son of the late Willie C. and Lizzie D. Still.
