North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Cobie W. Williams, 92, who entered into rest September 20, 2021, will be conducted Thursday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Rev. Frank E. Barker officiating. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Williams was a native of Laurens County, Georgia, having made North Augusta his home for the past 67 years. He was a US Army veteran and member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71. Mr. Williams retired as an engineer from E.I. DuPont and Westinghouse at the Savannah River Site with 42 years of service. Additionally, he worked as a real estate broker for 40 years. Mr. Williams was a Christian and active member of Immanuel Baptist Church. He was a member of the North Augusta Sertoma Club, North Augusta Lions Club and the Acacia Masonic Lodge #315 AFM. Mr. Williams was preceded in death by his wife Lois Jackson Williams and his daughter, Linda W. Callaway.

Pallbearers will be members of the North Augusta All-Stars golf group. Survivors include his granddaughter, Tina Thompson Hawes and her husband Jason, North Augusta, SC; two great-grandchildren, Taylor M. Hawes and Colby J. Hawes, both of North Augusta, SC.

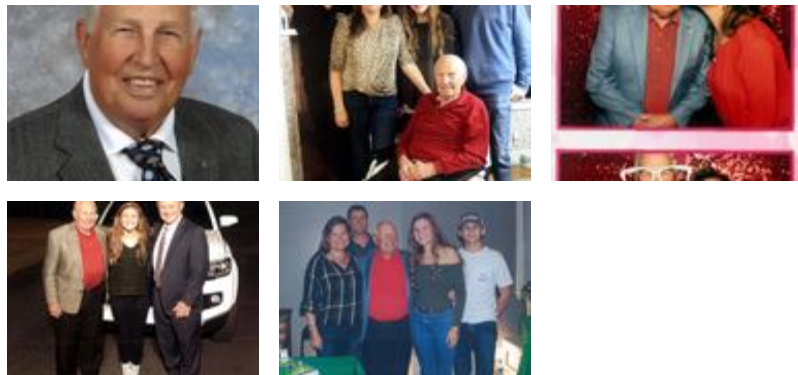
