Aiken, SC – Funeral Services for Major Cornelius “Neil” Edward Fleeman, IV, 73, who went to the arms of Jesus at home on February 3, 2025, surrounded by his loving family will be conducted this Friday afternoon at 2 o’clock from First Baptist Church North Augusta, Rev. Mark Owens and Rev. Roy Kiser officiating. Private interment will take place with Full Military Honors at Fort Jackson National Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service. His family finds comfort knowing that Neil’s faith carried him to his eternal home after years of declining health.

Neil was born in Athens, Georgia to the late Cornelius Edward Fleeman, III and Betty Earlene Baird on October 25, 1951.

After graduating from the University of Georgia, Neil served his country in the United States Air Force. Although he flew many planes, the F-4 Phantom Fighter Jet was his favorite. After serving 20 years active duty, he continued to wear the uniform and teach JROTC for 14 years. In 2005, Neil was awarded the Golden Apple Award for the CSRA.

In 1979, Neil married the love of his life, Sharon, and they spent 46 loving years together. Also left to cherish his memory are their children, Ken Grady and Kelly Henry (Jim). He was a devoted grandfather to Hannah and Jackson and in 2011 with enduring love, he made a place in his heart for grandsons

Alex, Ryan and Carter Henry. God has continued to bless this "PaPa" even more with greatgrands, Trenton, Brenton, Axl and Aleeah. Neil is also survived by two sisters, one brother and several nieces and nephews.

Neil was a faithful member of First Baptist Church North Augusta where he served on the Hospitality Team, Church Teller, Middle School Sunday School Teacher, Laces for Love Shoe Ministry and Operation Christmas Child. He was also a Gideon and a member of American Legion Post 71.
