Daisy C Lyle, born July 29th, 1928, in Atlanta Georgia, passed away peacefully on the 4th of January, 2025 at the age of 96. 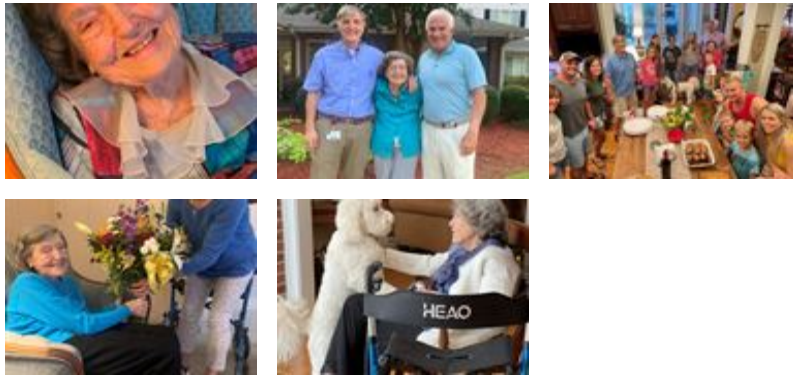
