Mr. Dimmick was a native of Fayetteville, NC, having made North Augusta his home for the past 15 years. He was a member of Victory Baptist Church. Mr. Dimmick retired as a SFC from the US Army with 20 years of service, worked as a nurse at the VA Medical Center and taught medical classes at Virginia College. He loved Fishing and was an incredible DJ known as "DeMIX." Mr. Dimmick had great compassion for our nation's veterans, especially those he served at the VA.
