Evans, GA – Mr. Daniel Louis “Dan” Saccone, 74, entered into rest March 31, 2024. A Celebration of Life will be held Friday morning, April 19th, at 11 o’clock at Stevens Creek Church. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service from 10 until 11 o’clock. Interment will be private.

Dan was born November 7, 1949, to the late Anthony Daniel Saccone and Rosemary Pantone Saccone. He was a native of Albany, NY, having made Evans, GA his home for the past 33 years. Dan was a Coast Guard veteran of six years and a 1972 graduate Fairleigh Dickenson University in New Jersey. He had a successful career as an electrical engineer which spanned 50 years and he recently retired from the Savannah River Site in 2023. Dan was a sports enthusiast, an avid golfer, and often volunteered to coach his son’s basketball and baseball teams. He was a devout Christian and a member of Stevens Creek Church. Dan indeed had a servant’s heart, constantly looked to help those in need, while his needs were always secondary. His undaunting faith, strength of character, godly wisdom, and service to others made him a true disciple of Jesus Christ. Dan will be fondly remembered for his kindest and devotion to wife, children, and grandchildren.
