We spent hours in those early years, picking blackberries, laughing, playing in the dirt. She loved her family and life. I still remember that day I really met her. It was in the North Augusta Church of God. After Sunday school, she introduced herself and said she knew I lived very near to her. Being painfully shy, I don't think I said anything. I was flabbergasted that she would pick me out of all the children to speak to and was baffled that she knew who I was. She flashed her beautiful smile, grabbed my hand and held it tight as we went into the church service. It was the beginning of something very powerful and wonderful in my life.

She was gifted with the talents of love, understanding, compassion, and wisdom. Yes, I'll always believe little Debbie Alexander with her envious dimples was placed in my life to keep me safe in my very early years, to be my friend, to teach me and to help me become the person I am today. 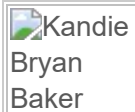
