Dr. Snyder was a native of Jackson, Mississippi, having made North Augusta her home for the past 20 years and was a member of the Belvedere First Baptist Church. She received her Bachelor's Degree from Mississippi College and her Master's and Doctorate from Tulane University. Dr. Snyder was the Assistant Chairman of the Biology Department at Augusta State University.

Survivors include her husband of 23 years, Rev. Tony Snyder; two sons, Jonathan Snyder and Adam Snyder, both of North Augusta; her mother, Lillian Lewis, Brandon, MS; two sisters, Michelle Chambers, Raymond, MS and Rhonda Short, Brandon, MS.
