Mrs. Doris Nell Gilliam Bellamy, 91, of Beech Island, South Carolina, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Saturday, October 21, 2023. She was preceded in death by her husband of 55 years, Harvey D. Bellamy, Sr. The funeral service will be conducted Tuesday, October 24, 2023, at 11 o'clock at Historic First Baptist Church of Beech Island with Pastor Greg Williams officiating. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service. Interment will follow in the church cemetery.
