North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mrs. Dorothy "Dot" Bess Burnette Aiken, 91, who entered into rest February 14, 2019, will be conducted Saturday morning at 11 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Mrs. Aiken was a native of Montmorenci, South Carolina, having made North Augusta her home for the past 41 years. She was a descendant of Daniel Burnette, the founder of Burnettetown, South Carolina. Mrs. Aiken and her late husband, Floyd V. Aiken, Jr., were graduates of Langley-Bath-Clearwater High School. She was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church for 20 years. In 1992, she retired as a Bookkeeper from Midland Valley High School. As a volunteer at University Hospital, Mrs. Aiken logged more than 10,000 hours of service and was interviewed by television Channels 26 and 12 concerning this miraculous achievement. She was an active member of the National Association of Educational and Office Professionals (NAEOP) and the South Carolina Association of Educational and Office Professionals (SCAEOP) where she was instrumental in founding a retiree division (SCAEOP-R). In honor of her service, The Dot Aiken Scholarship was established by the SCAEOP-R, to assist young people in their education.

Mrs. Aiken loved to travel and visited places such as Oberammergau, Germany where she attended "The Passion Play " in 2000, Salzburg, Austria and Venice, Italy. She also enjoyed gardening and crochet.

Survivors include two sons, Wade S. (Judy) Aiken, Covington, GA and Dr. Jay B. (Rebekah Stanford) Aiken, North Augusta; two grandsons, Harrison (Ansley) Aiken and Hunter Aiken both of Atlanta, GA; and a great-grandchild, Baxlee Rae Aiken.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home this Friday evening from 5 until 7.
