Graniteville, SC – Graveside Services for Mrs. Dorothy “Teet” Quiller Newsome, 77, who entered into rest July 13, 2022, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o’clock in the Jacksonville Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery. Rev. Joshua Bryant eulogist and Rev. James Arthur Adams presiding. A final viewing will be held at the church one hour prior to the service from 1 until 2 o'clock. 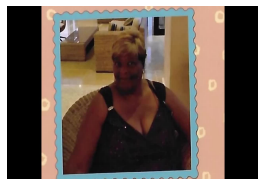
