North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Earl Baynham, 82, who entered into rest December 12, 2013, will be conducted Monday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Dr. Gary Redding and Dr. Randy Cooper officiating. Interment in Pineview Memorial Park.

Mr. Baynham was a life-long resident of North Augusta and a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. He retired from the Savannah River Site with 42 years of service. Mr. Baynham was a loving husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He enjoyed fishing, golfing, and spending time with his family. In 2006, Mr. Baynham was honored by being inducted into the North Augusta Sports Hall of Fame and again in 2013 as part of the 1949 State Champion Baseball Team. He was preceded in death by a brother, Ramon Baynham and two sisters, Jewell Boehmer and Ann Walton.
