North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Earl F. McGrory, 92, formerly of Hammond House, who entered into rest September 12, 2017, will be conducted Friday morning at 10 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Deacon Robert Hookness officiating. Interment in Beaufort National Cemetery, Beaufort, SC, at 2 o'clock with Veterans Honors.

Mr. McGrory was a native of Providence, Rhode Island, a former resident of North Augusta for 33 years, having made Warner Robins his home for the past 7 months. He was a parishioner of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church, a member of the American Legion Jessie C. Lynch Memorial Post #71, the Mendel Rivers Chapter DAV, and former District Governor of the Wickford Lions Club. Mr. McGrory was owner of McGrory Custom Canvas and was a U. S. Navy Veteran, having served in World War II,. He was preceded in death by his wife, Jeannette Whitmarsh McGrory, a daughter, Patricia Grant and a grandson, Justin McGrory.

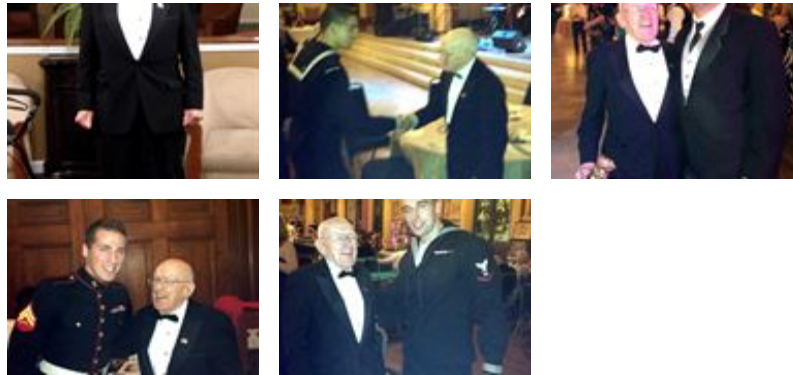
