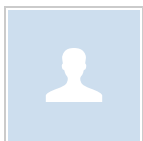

“Daddy I am so sorry I hurt your feelings . I never stopped loving you. I never stopped thinking about you. I have missed you during every important event and milestone. I have my memories and a few pictures and they are enough. You were the person that taught me how to be a kid. I remember so much we did. I remember being in trouble and not being able to watch cartoons one day and while they were on you sat with me and played so I would not think about what I was missing. You taught me how to balance a gallon milk jug on my arm so I could drink it straight from the carton like you and not spill it . I remember the baby turtles and tiny frogs you brought me home from the test track at E-Z-Go and building me walking stilts and teaching me how to use them. Going fishing with Granddaddy and I was the only one to catch a fish. You were so proud of my fish and got angry at me because I would not hold that fish with my hand for a picture so you got me a stringer and fussed the whole time that it was messing up the picture ! But you had that picture in your office anyway ! When my dog ran off you brought me home another one from behind granddaddy’s shop. You were the only one that could get me to eat when I had my tonsil out I was so afraid so you made me pancakes and told me it was ok they were soft. You also taught me I hate golf when you thought it would be fun for me to be your caddy and you looked around for me and I was still at the last hole chasing ducks !! You taught me to play video games and rebuild carburetor and with a screw driver you can start a car off of a solenoid . You used to sneak me cokes at granddaddy’s repair shop. Because mama would not allow me to have them. She said they were bad for you and would rot my teeth. So you taught me to “break into” the coke machine in the back. It was just a pair of pliers my granddaddy had rigged up to open the machine. He always paid to stock the machine. Eating push-ups from hilderbrants and to use Gojo after working on cars. I remember when you let me cut your hair with a razor when I was teenager because you said it was gonna be short anyway because you hated the curls. And the time you wanted me to walk on your back so I decided to help you crack it instead and you had to go to the chiropractor to get it fixed. You bought my first makeup because

*mama said I could not wear until I was 16 so you bought me some when I was 14 because my friends were wearing it. I remember the first time I thought I lost you was on my 13 th birthday after my party there was a big storm. You were standing at the door with your hand on the storm door. And lightning struck you It knocked you about 20 feet backwards. Me and mama beat the ambulance to the hospital ! You taught me to listen to all music and play chess with/against uncle Jerry and that you knew I watering down your rum because its not supposed to bubble when you pour it ! You also taught me I was stronger than I thought I could be and I have been up until today. Today when I saw your obituary was when I knew I was not as strong as I thought I was. You will always be in my heart. You were the first man I ever loved. You were my daddy. You always will be. I love you, Wendy Grigsby Crawley*

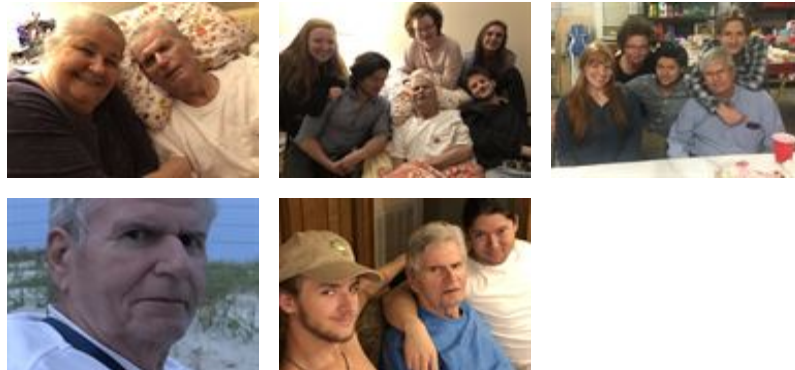
