



## Fatemeh Noora Jamir

November 2, 1939 - August 19, 2023

North Augusta, SC – Funeral services for Fatemeh Noora Jamir (“Noora”), 83, who entered into rest August 19, 2023, will be conducted Friday morning at 11 o’clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel. The family will host a reception following the service at the Camellia Hall of Lookaway Inn in North Augusta.

Noora was born November 2, 1939, to the late Abdul Sami Shahidpour and Tabandeh Vahidi. She was raised in Nayriz, Iran, and immigrated to the United States in 1969 where she later became a U.S. citizen in 1984. She made North Augusta, SC, her home for the past 37 years.

Noora graduated from nursing school in Abadan, Iran, and she also held a bachelor’s in nursing from the Medical College of Georgia. She was a nurse in Iran and across the U.S. in New York City, NY; Evanston, IL; Okmulgee, OK; Athens, GA; and Augusta, GA. Noora was a nurse at the Medical College of Georgia for more than 20 years before retiring. Noora was a devout member of the Baha’i Faith.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by Vinson Frank Jamir, her dear husband of 25 years. Surviving family members left to cherish Noora’s memory include her 8 siblings and her 2 daughters, Joy Jamir and Nahal Suzanne Jamir.

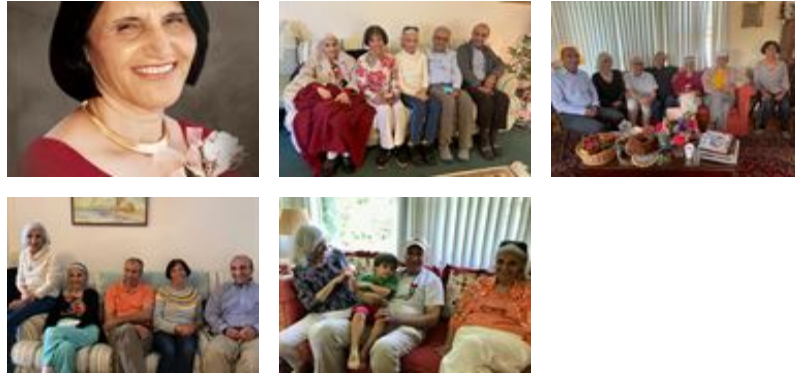
