



Frank Allen "Al" Mink Jr.

March 9, 1929 - January 6, 2019

North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Frank Allen Mink, Jr., 89, who entered into rest January 6, 2019, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Immanuel Baptist Church, Rev. Frank Barker officiating. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Mink moved to North Augusta in 1958 from New Orleans. He graduated from Lehigh University and earned his Master's degree from Georgia Tech. Mr. Mink was a longtime member of Immanuel Baptist Church where he was a member of the Calhoun Sunday School class and a Sunday School teacher and deacon for many years. He volunteered at Riverview Park and was a member of the Jesse C. Memorial American Legion Post 71. Mr. Mink was preceded in death by his parents Frank Allen Mink, Sr. and Helen Mink; a brother, Kenneth S. Mink

Survivors include his wife of 64 years, Christine Bates Mink; two daughters, Melanie (Bob) Beauston and Martha (Terry) Fletcher; a son, Frank (Mary Beth) Mink, III; five grandchildren Christy Fletcher, Casey Beauston, Allison Fletcher, Danae Beauston and Jessica Mink.

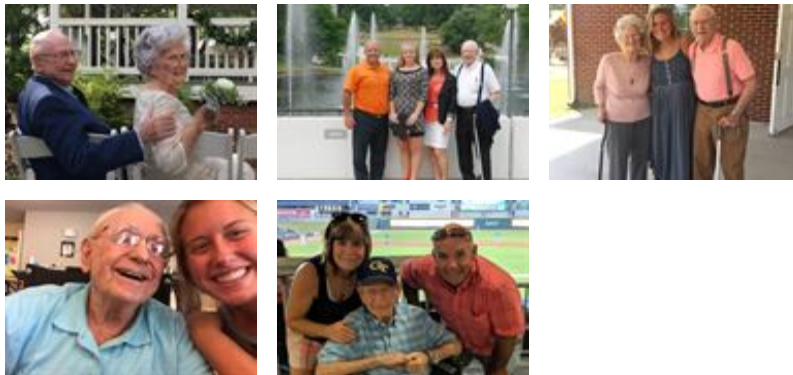
