Mr. Reeder was a native of Augusta, having made Jackson his home for the past 53 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Jackson where he had served as Chairman of the Board of Deacons, Chairman of the Finance Committee, Sunday School Director and a member of the Baracca II Sunday School Class. Mr. Reeder was retired from the US Navy with 35 years of service and also retired from the Savannah River Site with 32 years of service and was a Past Master of the Hopewell Masonic Lodge #127 AFM.
