



Dr. Gary Clark Redding

August 14, 1945 - June 12, 2024

Augusta, GA – Memorial Services for Dr. Gary Clark Redding, 78, who entered into rest June 12, 2024, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at First Baptist Church of North Augusta, Dr. Will Dyer and Rev. Mark Owens officiating. Private interment will take place in First Baptist Church of Augusta's Memorial Garden. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Tuesday evening from 5 until 7.

Dr. Redding was born August 14, 1945, in Griffin, Georgia to the late J.B. and Velma Redding. He served the Lord for over 40 years as a Pastor in Florida and South Carolina, including 22 years at First Baptist Church of North Augusta where he grew, not only the size of the congregation, but also the physical plant of the church campus. Dr. Redding's heart was as a Pastor and shepherding the people to a relationship with the Lord. His happiest moments were with family, especially his grandchildren who affectionately called him, "Buddy." In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Kenneth Redding.

Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Carol Redding; daughters, Melissa Tripp (Ryan) and Jennifer Wilson (Rusty); grandchildren, Brayden Tripp, Benjamin Tripp, Barrett Tripp, Finn Wilson, Isla Wilson and Birdie Wilson.
