Edgefield, SC—Mr. George A. Bryant, 81, answered God’s call to his heavenly home January 24, 2022. Funeral Services will be conducted Friday morning at 11:30 in Big Stevens Creek Baptist Church with Dr. Skip Meyer and Rev. Eric Bruton officiating. Interment in the church cemetery with Veteran Honors. The family will receive friends at the church from 10 o’clock until the time of the service. 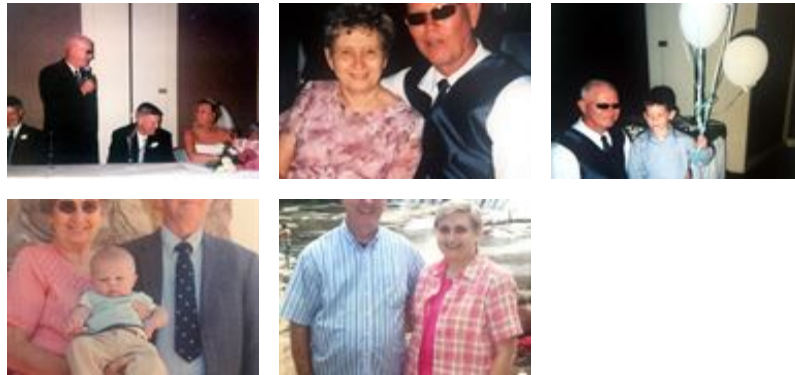
