Harlem, GA – Mr. George William “Bill” Evans passed in peace, Friday, July 28, 2023, at the age of 82. Funeral services will be conducted Tuesday afternoon, August 1, 2023, at 2 o’clock from The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Harlem, GA. Interment will follow in Westview Cemetery, Thomson, GA, with Full Military Honors. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service from 1 until 2 o’clock.

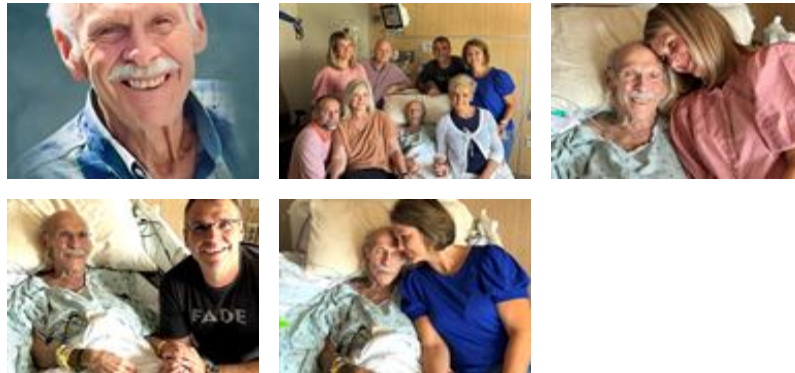
