Warrenville, SC—Memorial Services for George W. Mr. Fowler, who was born in St. Louis, Missouri, was a resident of Saluda, SC and Aiken, SC, and then resided in Warrenville, SC for the past 5 years. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Aiken and was a former member of Butler United Methodist Church in Saluda. Mr. Fowler received his Masters of Business Administration from Emory University and a Bachelor of Science from the University of South Carolina Aiken. He was the co-owner of Butler Hill Guernsey Farm in Saluda until 1990 and later worked and retired as a Financial Analyst for Westinghouse at the Savannah River Site. He was a Scout Master with the Boy Scouts of America, a member of the Farm Bureau, and member of the American Guernsey Association. He enjoyed gardening, woodworking, and reading. He was preceded in death by his wife and mother of his children, Brenda Langford Fowler, his parents, George W. Fowler, Sr. and Ethel Leverich Fowler, and two sisters, Alicia and Anita.

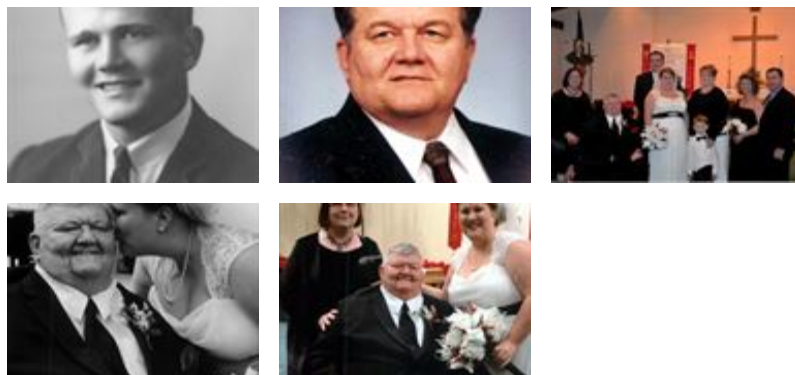
