North Augusta, SC—The Mass of Christian Burial for Mr. Gerald A. Shanahan, 84, who entered into rest November 3, 2018 will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock from Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. Rev. J. Renaurd West officiating. Mr. Shanahan was a native of Illinois, having made North Augusta his home for the past 63 years. He was a member of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church and was a Fourth-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus Council 7062. Mr. Shanahan was a US Army Veteran, was a part of the original design team that designed the B-52 bomber and retired from Civil Service with over 40 years of service. He was a long-time Dixie Youth Baseball and Football Coach and volunteer with Scouting. Mr. Shanahan loved golf and Lionel Trains and volunteered at the Masters Golf Tournament for over 35 years.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Becky Shanahan; a son, Gerald A. Shanahan, Jr.; a daughter, Christine Dozier.

Survivors include a son and daughter-in-law, Patrick and Cheryl Shanahan, North Augusta, SC; two grandchildren, Jarod Shanahan and Jayce Shanahan;

a brother, Sean Shanahan; a sister, Mary Shanahan; and his special friend, Leilani Usry.

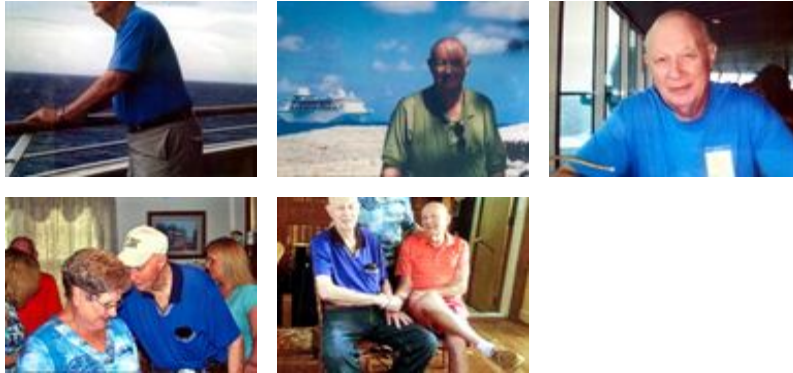
