Belvedere, SC—The Mass of Christian Burial for Miss Grace L. Delaney, 89, of Belvedere, SC, who died June 19, 2006, will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock from Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. Father Peter Clarke celebrant. Miss Delaney was a native of Lexington, Kentucky, having made Belvedere her home for 35 years. She was a communicant of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church, a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71, a former member of the Pilot Club, the Augusta Genealogical Society and a former board member of the Matte C. Hall Nursing Home. Miss Delaney retired from the U.S. Army with the rank of Major and was a Veteran of World War II. She was retired from the Medical College of Georgia, where she established the Premature Nursery.

Survivors include several nieces and nephews.
