



Gregory Blair Scurlock

August 29, 1948 - November 4, 2017

Mr. Gregory Blair Scurlock, 69, passed away with his family at his side, Saturday, November 4, 2017. A memorial service will be held on Wednesday morning at 11 o'clock at Reid Memorial Presbyterian Church with Dr. Matt Rich officiating. A reception to honor Greg's life will follow the service at the church.

Greg's 40 plus year banking career began in 1971 at First National Bank & Trust Company of Augusta as a management trainee and commercial lender. He worked with Smith Barney as a licensed stock broker as well as First National Bank of South Carolina in bond sales. Greg also worked at Georgia Railroad Bank and Trust Co. (Augusta), First Union National Bank and Wachovia in commercial banking and wealth management. After a short retirement he went back to work for First Bank of Georgia where he retired in 2014.

Greg's education includes a B.S. in Business Administration, Marketing at the University of South Carolina. Additionally he completed the Georgia Banking School at the University of Georgia, Commercial Credit School at Darden School of Business, University of Virginia and Stonier Graduate School of Banking, Rutgers University. As a community volunteer, he served on the Augusta Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, University Healthcare Foundation-Chairman 1991-1992, the Gertrude Herbert Art Institute Board of

Directors, Tuttle-Newton Home Board of Directors, American Cancer Society, American Heart Association, United Way Campaign and United Way Budget Panel, Security Land and Development Corp. Board of Directors, Reid Memorial Presbyterian board of deacons and session as well as stewardship campaign chairman, Exchange Club of Augusta and The Augusta Golf Association. Greg had a lifelong love of the game of golf which he passed down to his sons, Blair and Brian. For over 30 years, they have been able to travel and play some of the great courses of the world. At Augusta Country Club, Greg was a past Club Champion, Senior Club Champion and Mid-Am Champion. He along with Tom Wilson, won the Georgia State 4-Ball in 1984. Greg won the Georgia State Senior 4-Ball in 2014 with Charlie Wall, Sr. In 2004, he was Medalist at the U.S. Senior Amateur Championship in Los Angeles which qualified him to play in the British Senior Amateur in Saunton, England.

Greg passed his love for the South Carolina Gamecocks to his boys and they attended many a football game together. He was a funny, kind and humble man who was loved by many. Greg will be sorely missed but the grace and dignity with which he handled his 14 year battle with cancer was a wonderful example to his family and friends. His understanding of the Bible came down to what Jesus said in John 13:34, We must love one another.

He leaves to cherish his memory his wife Lisa Fortson Scurlock; two sons, Blair Scurlock (Stephanie), Roswell, GA and Brian Scurlock (Ansley), Greenville, SC; a stepson, Brent Moody (Tasha), Atlanta, GA; a stepdaughter, Elizabeth Johnson (Erik), Atlanta, GA; four grandchildren, Pope, Ethan, Tripp and Parker Scurlock; three step grandchildren, Hudson and Isla Moody and Crew Johnson; a sister, Susan Allen (John), Houston, TX; a niece, Ashley Allen; two nephews, Jack Allen and Cameron Allen. He was preceded in death by his parents Mary and Blair Scurlock of North Augusta.
