Augusta, GA—Memorial Services for Mr. Harry O. Herrmann, Sr., 85, of Greene Street, Augusta, GA, who entered into rest April 25, 2009, will be conducted Tuesday morning at 9 o'clock in St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church. Father David F. O. Mr. Herrmann was a native of Philadelphia, PA and former resident of Satellite Beach, FL and North Augusta, SC. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran of World War II and played professional baseball in the Cincinnati Reds organization. He was also a 30-year veteran of the U.S. Space Program at Cape Canaveral where he participated in the Mercury, Apollo and Space Shuttle space exploration missions. He was a Master Mason with the Beach Masonic Lodge 354 in Indiatlantic, FL, where he received an award for more than 50 years of service.

Survivors include his wife of 61 years, Lillian H. Herrmann; two sons and daughters-in-law, Jack & Linda Herrmann, Harry & Rosie Herrmann, all of North Augusta, SC; four grandchildren: Erik Herrmann, Tampa, FL; Tara Drew, Atlanta, GA; Cheryl Bruno, Huntsville, AL; and Mark Herrmann, Augusta, GA; and four great-grandchildren.
