



Haynes Stanley Norris

North Augusta, SC – Graveside Services for Mr. Haynes Stanley Norris, 89, who entered into rest December 11, 2023, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 1 o'clock at Southlawn Cemetery with Pastor Greg Williams officiating. The family will receive friends at the graveside following the service.

Mr. Norris was born March 26, 1934, in Mountain City, TN to the late David and Winnie Norris. He graduated from Johnson County High School. Mr. Norris was a Vietnam Veteran and retired after 24 years of service to this country in the United States Air Force. Upon retirement from the military, he worked and retired from GlaxoSmithKline after several years of service. Mr. Norris was an active member of the Historic First Baptist Church of Beech Island where he was an usher and volunteered with the buildings and grounds as well as Carpenters for Christ. He would often spend time at the lake and enjoyed fishing, travel, but most of all spending time with his family. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 66 years, Mary Nell Norris; sisters, Roma Ketron and Nita Duffield; brothers, Virlon Norris and Justus Norris.

Survivors include his daughter, Teresa N. Graybill (James David); son, Thomas D. Norris (Janet); two grandchildren, Jessica Norris and Nathanael Graybill; and many nieces and nephews.
