North Augusta, SC—Memorial Services for Mrs. Helen LaVera Richardson Scott, 84, of North Augusta who entered into her final rest on April 3, 2015, will be conducted Saturday, April 18, at 2 o'clock in St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church. Rev'd David F.O. Thompson officiating.

Helen was born October 9, 1930 in Wyoming County WV. She grew up during the Great Depression, in the coal-mining mountain hollow of Glen Rogers where she achieved valedictorian of her high school class. Helen went on to Morgantown to earn a degree at West Virginia University, then became a pioneering female accountant at DuPont & Co, where she met her life mate Mr. John L. Scott; she married Jack in 1953 in Wilmington DE. They moved to North Augusta in 1974 where she joined H&R Block and had a 40-year career as a tax-preparer, serving CSRA clients who often became friends.

Helen bestowed life and love upon her four children: Nancy Scott Baer, Pickens, SC (Jim), John R. Scott (deceased), Mark C. Scott, Tamassee, SC (Tina), and James H. Scott, North Augusta (Shari). She is further survived by a sister Betty Richardson Fonner, Morgantown, as well as five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren in whom she took great pleasure. She was widowed in 2009. Helen became a member of Saint Bartholomew's Episcopal Church where she served many years as Treasurer, member of the Vestry and choir member. She was proud of being a member of the Daughters of the

American Revolution, an ardent gardener, and enjoyed traveling with Elderhostel. Her open heart and generous spirit graced her family and many friends throughout her full life.

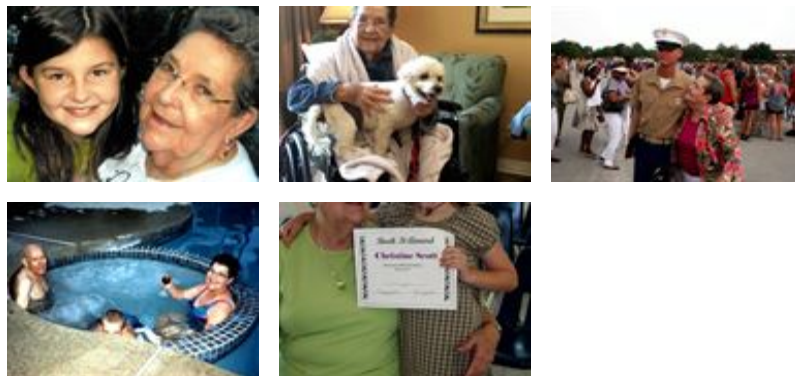
