North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Henry Levon Cribb, 89, who entered into rest January 2, 2026, will be conducted Wednesday morning at 11 o'clock from Grace United Methodist Church, Rev. Mr. Cribb was born April 5, 1936, in McColl, SC to the late Liston and Callie Cribb. He served his country in the United States Air Force. 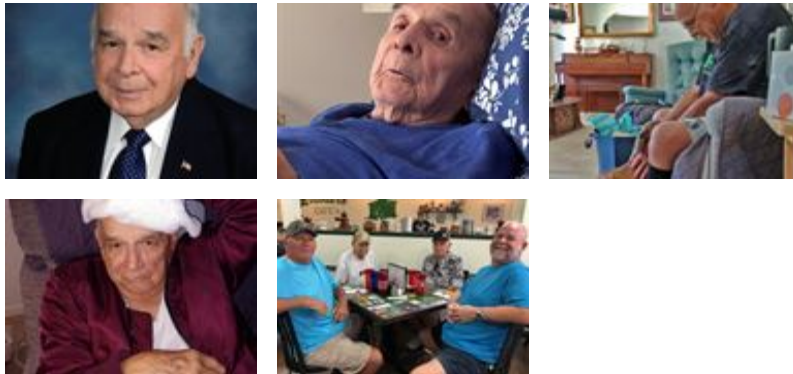
