Mr. Ensley was a native of Ashville, North Carolina, a former resident of North Augusta, having made Martinez his home. He attended the University of South Carolina and Clemson University and a U.S. Navy Veteran. Mr. Ensley was a member of the First Baptist Church of Augusta, where he served as a Deacon and was involved in Missions having served Mission assignments in Tanzania, Africa, Panama Canal and Guatemala. Shortly after 9-11, he volunteered to assist at Ground Zero in three separate assignments. Mr. Ensley was dedicated to mission work at home and abroad. He was employed as a Computer Engineer with Hewlett-Packard and was the son of the late Mr. Howard P. Ensley, Sr.

Survivors include his mother, Donnies Ensley, North Augusta; a sister and brother-in-law, Brenda and Theron Huskey, North Augusta; a niece and her husband, Margie and Dave Heimer, Greensboro, GA; a nephew and his wife, David and Kathy Huskey and their children Drew and Maggie Huskey, all of North Augusta.

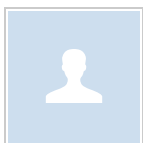
